NOX Energy Team,

Thanks for the work you have conducted to date in relation to the Metro South Health EV charger project. I am pleased to confirm that the NOX Energy EV charging solution will be installed into three of our Community Health sites. Initially, will install 13 EV chargers, split into groups of 8, 3, and 2 to test the system in various usage scenarios. The pilot phase will allow us to assess the effectiveness and efficiency of the solution in real world settings and evaluate the satisfactory performance of the solution.

In the rollout of the EV charger project, we have identified a number of site risks and infrastructure capacity constraints. The NOX Energy solution will overcome some of the risks due to the low cost implementation, intelligent charge management capabilities and the ease of integration with the existing infrastructure.

In addition to the current EV charger project, approval has been given by Queensland Health for two additional multi storey carparks within Metro South Health, housing approximately 1000 car spaces each. It is expected that a reasonable quantity of the car spaces will require EV chargers, in line with district needs and NCC compliance requirements.

We look forward to continuing to utilise the expertise of the NOX Energy team to enhance the accessibility and availability of the EV charging facilities for our patients, staff and visitors across the large number of sites within Metro South Health, and the impact it will have on promoting sustainable transportation solutions.
